Instrument Levels: BEG (beginner) is if you've never played before or are just starting out. P/B (past beginner) is if you already know a little bit about your instrument and can play a tune or two with help.

***Recorders:** Bring your soprano recorder. First time students may receive one free recorder. If you have lost or forgotten your free one, you may buy one for \$4

Mountain Dulcimers: We have a limited number to loan out for class participants during the festival. Ask a Youth Coordinator.

Hammered Dulcimers and Autoharps: limited number to loan out for use during class-time only. Ask a Youth Coordinator.

ODPC Dulcimer Education & Loan Program: (see handout in Youth Area or at the ODPC Office) New and prospective players have the opportunity to get real, hands-on experience with a loaner hammered dulcimer, to use for up to one year. We will try to assign a mentor nearby to provide instruction or to help find a suitable teacher.
